



## Overview

Clipstone House is a registered care service which embraces and balances the management of risk with comfort, homeliness, dignity, respect and choice. The service is for males and females who have learning disabilities, autism and sensory and communication impairments. The staff team are specialists in working with complex needs and behaviours which may appear to challenge services. The service is staffed 24 hours a day by a dedicated team of Registered Manager, Nurses and Support Workers.

The unique building design provides six single person apartments and communal spaces includes, lounges, dining room, sensory spaces and laundry. Each apartment has its own lounge diner, bedroom with ensuite wet room and own private garden.

The service is designed for individuals who require a high level of support to live within a community setting and who will continue to require this longer term. Clients may be referred who are transitioning from hospital, a children's service or where their community placement is no longer viable. The service aims to support people to return to their family or home area.

The aim of the service is to encourage individuals to lead a full and valued life, enabling them to live more independently through a programme of active community engagement, developing meaningful social networks and coping strategies.

## We provide:

- Individually tailored support
- Strengths based approach
- Positive Behavioural Support (PBS)
- Staff trained in responding to behaviours seen as challenging
- Access to meaningful and stimulating activity, including vocational and educational opportunities
- Developing independent living skills and community engagement
- A strong emphasis on safeguarding
- Access to independent advocacy
- Strong multiagency and family carer partnerships to ensure a holistic care pathway

The service is located in Clipstone in Nottinghamshire. There are a range of local amenities including, shops, parks and primary care facilities. Clipstone is 20 minutes from Mansfield by car or public transport and has good transport links throughout the county.
